Fees Policy

Be Gymnastics aims to provide affordable gymnastics classes and opportunities for all and communicate any changes regarding prices as soon as possible to the parents/carers.

Trials

A trial fee for a class is the price of one session and must be paid in advance to secure the trial space.

After a trial, **if the child would like to continue then it is the parent/carers responsibility to inform us as quick as possible** so that we can invoice for the remainder of the month. This invoice must be paid before the next week to secure the space (we cannot hold a space without payment unfortunately).

If we are not notified that the child would like to continue, then the space may be offered to someone else.

The **trial fee for any class is non-refundable** however if cancelled by the club then the trial will be rearranged. Trials are set for the week after you receive the invite email, we are unable to hold a space for a trial any longer. If you wish for your trial to be a couple of weeks later, you will be required to pay for the space in the class leading up to the trial also.

Class Fees

Class fees are invoiced around the 23rd of each month and are due by the 1st of each month in advance.

We use a management site called ClassForKids to manage payments and classes. **A late fee of £15 will be added by the system each month if fees are not paid on time.** As a charity, we heavily rely on fees and if these are not paid, we simply cannot pay the rent, utilities and coaches.

Fees can be paid via ClassForKids (on the link emailed out on the 23rd of each month), PayPal (begymnasticsclub@gmail.com), cash or card at reception. These options are stated on the invoices also.

If a gymnast does not wish to continue training, then please notify the club as soon as possible. If you fail to notify us, then you will still be required to pay the next month of fees. There is no class refund for the remainder of the month if a gymnast leaves part way through a month, unless the month of classes has not yet started.

If a recreational class is cancelled by the club then a deduction on the invoice for the following month will be added however if classes are cancelled due to government advise/safety then this is down to the discretion of the trustees and club.

If a squad session is cancelled by the club or a squad session isn't running due to a bank holiday then gymnasts are welcome to attend another session of the same discipline within the next 2 weeks. In a situation where a gymnast already attends all the squad sessions for that discipline within the week then they may be able to use a workshop to catch up their session, this must be agreed beforehand. No refunds/deductions are given as squad fees are based on a monthly amount not an hourly rate.

If a gymnast is unable to attend class for whatever reason then no refund will be issued as you are paying for the space within the class. Please notify us before class, if your child is unable to attend. A message or email is perfect.

If a gymnast is away for a period of time, then you will still be required to pay the monthly fee to keep the space. Another child (i.e. friend or sibling) cannot use the space in the meantime.

If a gymnast has a substantial injury such as a broken bone or signed out of sport for recovery/operation etc then the monthly fee will be halved until the gymnast can return to training. For squad gymnasts, it may be possible for gymnasts to attend training for conditioning and rehabilitation only during this period.

If you have any issues regarding payment, please pop us an email.

Additional Fees

When joining the club, a **one-off £15 joining/set up fee per household** is to be made for recreational gymnasts (this will be added to the first invoice) to help with general upkeep and equipment. This **joining fee is non-refundable and is due after the trial**.

Our competitive squad gymnasts are required to pay an **annual club subscription of £25** to help with equipment and coaches travel to and from competitions, due in April/May each year.

Workshop Fees

Workshop spaces are bookable on ClassForKids (link via our website) are not secure until payment has been received – payment is required at the time of booking.

Fees for our holiday workshops are non-refundable, however if you are unable to attend and more than 48 hours notice is given, we may be able to move the booking to another workshop during that holiday period providing there is space.

Private Sessions

Private sessions can be booked via email or on our socials, payment is due in advance via cash, card, PayPal or we can send a payment link out.

If you are unable to attend a booked private session for whatever reason or do not show up, no refund or transfer of private session can be given (as we are still required to pay for our coaches time). If more than 48 hours notice, is given then we may be able to re-arrange your private session.

Insurance

British Gymnastics Insurance is a requirement for all gymnasts. Gymnasts must sign up to British Gymnastics if they would like to attend regular classes after their trial. The insurance is an **annual fee of £24 (more for competitive gymnasts)** each year and is payable directly to British Gymnastics, this also includes access to the Rise Hub so your gymnasts can be assessed on the Rise Gymnastics Award Scheme. The link to sign up for British Gymnastics Insurance will be emailed out after your trial along with Dojo details.

Without British Gymnastics insurance, your child will not be able to attend class.

Please note that if these policy is not followed, then you are risking your gymnasts place in the club.
